The LT Community Advisory Council (LTCAC) is looking for new student members. The LTCAC was founded as part of the Peaceable Schools Initiative to strengthen the partnership of LT's students, staff, families, and the larger community. Our seventy members include sixteen students, ten faculty, and forty-four parents and other community residents from all parts of LT's large attendance area. We meet five times a year (on Wednesday evening) to hear presentations by the Superintendent and to discuss major issues affecting the high school. Student members have an active voice in our discussions and in suggesting solutions and priorities.

Recently, recommendations made by LTCAC to the Board of Education have addressed: LT's emergency crisis plan; LT's recruitment and retention of teachers and staff; the new Humanities program; and changes to LT's driver's education program.
